Experience the revival of the Jewish community in Slovenia and meet some of the community

Be surrounded by stunning mountainscapes in the charming village of Kranjska Gora, before heading to the town of Bled to take a boat ride to a tiny island surrounded by crystal clear waters. Take an informative city tour around Ljubljana.

Visit Prague, home to some of the most beautiful synagogues in the world and visit Jewish spaces

Spend time in Prague, seeing all of the beautiful architectural aspects of the city, with lots of opportunities for pictures in the idyllic city centre. Take part in a walking tour of Karlovy Vary Town before heading back to the hotel.

Spend time in the city of Salzburg, Mozart's birthplace, including a visit to the infamous love-lock bridge where teens will be invited to join the centuries old tradition. Take a tour and explore Vienna with local guides.

Pricing for BBYO Europe Tour 2023 is £3575 for members and £3600 for non-members. This includes return flights from London to the start point in Europe, accommodations, meals, touring, entrance fees, private transportation, basic medical insurance, t-shirt, orientation, and guest speakers.
